SUPPORTING RURAL SOLUTIONS TO END HOMELESSNESS IN ALBERTA

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This funding supports communities in addressing homelessness in rural and remote Alberta, including First Nations and Métis Communities and Settlements. Communities located outside of Alberta's seven major cities are eligible to apply for this funding. The Government of Canada has invested \$4.8 million through the Reaching Home program for 2024–2026, administered by the Rural Development Network. The next Call for Proposals will launch in Fall 2025 to support projects in 2026–2028. Non-profits, municipalities, FCSS, and Indigenous Nations and organizations, are eligible to apply for Reaching Home funding.. Through this funding, we have been able to fund a diverse range of projects, including but not limited to the development of supportive housing, shelter operations, prevention programs, outreach services, housing liaisons, community navigators and culturally appropriate mental health services.
